President's Message

When the ball dropped in New York City on December 31st signaling it was finally 2024, many bankers across the country felt relieved that 2023 was finally over and looked optimistically to the year ahead.

It was a tumultuous year – four high profile bank failures (three in California) and a meteoric rise in interest rates made for a very tough banking environment. However, when it was all over, we exceeded our net income projections by 14%.

We entered 2024 with a new office in Oroville, and in an advantageous position to increase our market share in the north valley. We have a great staff who are redoubling their efforts to bring new customers to the Bank. At nearly \$500 million in assets in three locations, how we grow is evolving. We are leveraging our technology to better interact with our customers and are using exceptional service as our competitive advantage.

The Federal Reserve's focus on creating a soft landing for an overheated economy is likely to contain growth in the banking industry in 2024. We project our cash flow from loan repayments and new deposits will be invested in higher rate instruments to increase our interest income throughout this year and into 2025.

We appreciate our core group of dedicated and supportive shareholders who have been with us since our inception in 2006 and continue to be many of our best customers. Your ongoing support is invaluable. Our strength is our "Absolutely Outstanding Customer Service," and it will continue to make us the Best Bank in Town in all the towns we serve.






